

Phoebe was a rescue that came from a cow barn in Ellenburg NY, with four - 4 week old kittens in tow. Phoebe and her babies, (Paige, Prescilla, Princess, and Presley) needed medical attention, as most of our rescues do. When Phoebe and her kittens were completely vetted, they were ready for adoption. The Kittens were adopted into loving homes. However, no one wanted Phoebe. Phoebe was about 18 months old, a beautiful, cuddly, lovable and playful cat, but she was FIV+. Most individuals feel a FIV+ test result is a death sentence. Which is far from the truth. Many cats who test FIV+ can live perfectly normal lives, if steps are taken to protect them from a secondary disease.

Phoebe was with us for 3 years and 4 months (1217 days), however, we never give up hope that some one would come along and would want to adopt her or one of our other very special FIV+ kitties.

Finally, at the age of 5, we received an adoption application for Phoebe. We were thrilled, but apprehensive that when this potential adopter, whose name was Tammy, realized Phoebe was FIV+ she would no longer be interested in her. However, we couldn't have been more wrong. Tammy knew about the FIV virus, and was not overly concerned about the diagnosis. She knew what to expect from the virus and what to do.

The evening that Tammy met Phoebe it was love at first site. Phoebe seemed to know that she was going home with this wonderful woman. Phoebe left the shelter that night with Tammy, and was finally going to know the love of, and be a part of, a family.

A few days after Phoebe went to her new home, Tammy, sent us an update on Phoebe, who is now Chloe. She said "Chloe (formerly Phoebe) is such an angel! A playful, sweet, drop dead gorgeous love bug...everything I hoped for. I couldn't be happier to have found her". We are always happy when any of our cats and kittens get adopted, however, there is something very special and exciting about one getting adopted, who has been with us for a few years AND is FIV+. We couldn't be happier for Chloe and her human mom.
